Rules and Regulations

Membership

1. Pool membership is limited to the members of the community who are in good standing of the Newtown Crossing Community Association and their families who are residents of Newtown Crossing. The Association reserves the right to ask for proof of residency of any person who is listed on a pool application. NCCA assessments must be current before a pool application may be approved.
2. Individuals or family members who reside outside of Newtown Crossing may not obtain membership through a NCCA resident. Any NCCA resident families who are involved in such an act will have their pool membership revoked.
3. Families will only receive membership for those individuals living in the household.
4. Pool membership is NOT transferable.

Pool Hours

1. The pool opens for the season Memorial Day weekend. The pool will be open weekends only until the day following the last day of school for Council Rock School District. At that time the pool will be open for "in season" hours.
2. The pool is open seven days a week "in season" from 12:00pm until 8:00 pm.
3. The pool is reserved for swim lessons or other events most mornings from 9:00am to 12:00pm. The pool is available to rent for private parties from 8:30pm until midnight Friday and Saturday nights. Rental forms may be obtained at the pool during regular hours. Completed forms should be returned to the pool manager. Seven days advanced notice for pool rental is required. Applicants will be notified by phone upon the approval of their application by the pool manager.
4. All persons must leave the pool promptly at closing.
5. The pool manager or designated person in charge has the authority to close the pool at any time, without notice, when in his/her opinion it is necessary for the safety of the members.
6. In the event of inclement weather, it is the discretion of the pool manager or designated person if the pool is to be open or closed. If the pool closes due to a thunderstorm the pool will not re-open until 30 minutes after the last clap of thunder is heard. In the event of lightning the pool will not re-open until 45 minutes after the last sighting. In the event of heavy rain the pool will close until the bottom of the pool is visible.

Pool Admission

1. Your driver's license is your admission to the pool. In the case that you do not have a driver's license, a tag will be issued to you and that is your admission to the pool. No one is permitted on the pool grounds without the proper identification.
2. Lost badges can be replaced for the cost of \$3.00 per badge.
3. Badges may not be transferred or loaned. Violators will be required to leave the pool area and pool membership may be revoked.
4. The cost of property damage will be charged to the responsible person(s). In the case of property damage by minors the parents or guardians will be held responsible. Pool membership may be revoked until these costs are settled.
5. The Association is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property. Please leave you valuables at home. No employee of the pool is permitted to safeguard a member or guest's valuables.
6. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult who is 16 years of age or older. Under no circumstances will this rule be changed.
7. All persons use the pool at their own risk. The Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury. In the event of an injury a lifeguard must be notified immediately.

8. Parents or guardians are responsible for explaining the pool rules to their children.

Admission of Non-Member Guests

1. The Association recognizes that members may desire to bring guests to the pool and members are welcome to do so. However, please remember that our pool is small, and crowded at times, and is primarily for the enjoyment and use of its members. The Association reserves the right to limit the number of guest admissions. If you intend to have more than 5 guests on a certain day, please inform the manager two days in advance.
2. Daily Guest Pass

3. A twenty (20) visit Guest Pass is available for \$60.00
Passes will be punched once per guest visit. A maximum of two (2) passes may be purchased per member family.
4. All guests must be accompanied and registered by the sponsoring member. It is the member's responsibility to see that the guest(s) adheres to all NCCA pool rules and regulations. Failure to do so may result in the expulsion of the guest and suspension of pool membership. Members will be held responsible for any property damage caused by their guest(s). Members are expected to remain with their guest(s) at the pool for safety and liability reasons.
5. Guest passes may be revoked for any infraction of the rules.
6. Guest passes are not transferable or refundable.

Rules of Conduct, Health, and Safety

The following are **PROHIBITED**:

- Swimming while there is no lifeguard on duty
 - Glass containers or pop-top cans
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Pets
 - Metal/Sharp Objects/Sharp or Hard Toys in either pool.
 - Spitting/Spouting water or the blowing of ones nose in the pool
 - Eating, drinking, or chewing gum in the pool
 - Running on the pool deck
 - Horseplay inside the pool
 - Throwing or pushing others into the pool
1. Please drive slowly when entering or leaving the parking area. MAXIMUM speed is 5 mph.
 2. You may NOT enter the pool while under the influence of ANY substance.
 3. Only the Board of Directors of the Newtown Crossing Community Association may approve the use of alcoholic beverages on the pool grounds.
 4. The use of the wading pool is reserved for toddlers only. These children are the sole responsibility of their parents or guardians and must be supervised by them while in the wading pool.
 5. Admission may be refused to anyone with a cold, cough, inflamed eyes, infection, bandage or communicable disease.
 6. **ALL CHILDREN IN DIAPERS MUST WEAR TIGHT LEGGED RUBBER/PLASTIC PANTS IN BOTH POOLS.**
 7. There is NO diving in the areas marked "3 feet" or "4 feet".

8. The deep end may be used for swimming ONLY if the diving board is closed with the lifeguard's approval. No more than one person is permitted in the deep end when the diving board is in use.
9. Proper bathing attire must be worn in the pool
10. The pool is NOT a lavatory. Please do not use it as such.
11. The use of rafts is only permissible with the permission of the lifeguards.

General

1. The Board of Directors has given complete authority to the pool manager and the lifeguards to enforce all rules and regulations. Any decisions by the pool manager are final. Any argument with the manager or lifeguards will not be tolerated and may lead to suspension of pool membership.
2. Any appeals of the decisions of the pool manager or complaints about pool employees should be made to the Pool Committee.
3. These rules and regulations are subject to change at any time by the Pool Committee. The pool manager may make any discretionary changes if he/she judges them to be in the best interest of the health, safety or well being of the pool membership.
4. The Pool Committee welcomes any suggestions or comments from the general membership. There will be a suggestion box placed at the guardhouse so that you will have a chance to "voice" your suggestions. Please feel free to either use this box or contact any member of the pool committee with your ideas, suggestions, or complaints.
5. The pool committee welcomes suggestions for summer-time activities, events or parties to include the entire community. The pool committee will make every effort to accommodate the wishes of the membership in scheduling activities. There may be some assessment of the attendees to cover annual costs of such activities.
6. Activities that will be occurring at the pool will be posted on the bulletin board for members to access.
